

Cell Phone and Electronic Device Policy

Student use of cell phones has proven disruptive to Summit Academy classrooms. Therefore, the use of cell phones by students is prohibited. If a student has a cell phone at school, it must be kept put away. The same applies to electronic devices and headphones/earbuds.

Certain exceptions apply:

1. Students may use a cell phone to make or receive a text or phone call at the Summit office, with permission from office staff.
2. Students may use cell phones or other electronic devices in class with prior permission from the teacher, for educational purposes only.
3. Students may use cell phones or other electronic devices BRIEFLY at lunch with prior permission from Summit lunchroom staff.

Apart from these exceptions, all cell phones, electronic devices, and headphones/earbuds brought out during Summit classes, breaks, or lunch will be confiscated. Students may pick them up at the end of the day.
