## Cell Phone and Electronic Device Policy

Student use of cell phones has proven disruptive to Summit Academy classrooms. Therefore, the use of cell phones by students is prohibited. If a student has a cell phone at school, it must be kept put away. The same applies to electronic devices and headphones/earbuds.

## Certain exceptions apply:

- 1. Students may use a cell phone to make or receive a text or phone call at the Summit office, with permission from office staff.
- 2. Students may use cell phones or other electronic devices in class with prior permission from the teacher, for educational purposes only.
- 3. Students may use cell phones or other electronic devices BRIEFLY at lunch with prior permission from Summit lunchroom staff.

Apart from these exceptions, all cell phones, electronic devices, and headphones/earbuds brought out during Summit classes, breaks, or lunch will be confiscated. Students may pick them up at the end of the day.
