

2018-2019 Enrollment as a Full-Time Student Form

Students participating in the Concurrent Enrollment or ASCENT Enrollment Programs may choose to participate as a full-time district student. The chart below is a guide to help parents understand the difference between a home-based/part-time student and a full-time district student. The full-time program is open to students who are enrolled in the Jefferson County school district as traditional students, including students who transferred from a home-based/part-time time program. It is important for previously home-based students and their parents to understand the impact of becoming a full-time district student. The chart below outlines the differences according to Colorado homeschool law, **C.R.S. 22:33:104.5. Home-based education – legislative – definitions – guidelines.**

Home Based Education/Part-time

Jefferson County Full-time Student for Charter Schools

(1)	Parent chooses the proper education and training for their child with minimum state controls.	School District chooses education and training subject to state and district regulations.
(2)(a)	Sequential program of instruction for the education of a child takes place in the home by the child's parent or by an adult relative of the child designated by the parent.	All classes are taught by teachers certified through Federal and State requirements.
(3)(a)	The parent (adult relative) who is providing instruction in a non-public home-based educational program shall not be subject to the requirements of the "Colorado Educator Licensing Act of 1991".	Teachers are subject to the requirements of the "Colorado Educator Licensing Act of 1991".
(3)(b)	A child who is participating in a non-public home-based educational program shall not be subject to compulsory school attendance.	District students are subject to Colorado compulsory school attendance.
(3)(e)	Parent shall notify school district of their intent to establish a home-based program.	District students are enrolled in the school district, so no notification is necessary.
(3)(f)	Students are required to participate in a nationally standardized achievement test in grades 3,5,7,9, and 11 to evaluate the student's academic progress.	District students are subject to all district testing requirements per their grade level.
(3)(g)	The records shall be maintained on a permanent basis by the parent in charge and in control of said program. The records shall include attendance, test and evaluation results, and immunizations.	The records shall be maintained on a permanent basis by the school district. The records shall include attendance, test and evaluation results, immunizations and a high school transcript which includes previous home school course work. College grades become part of the student's permanent record. Students are required to work towards meeting Jefferson County's Graduation requirements.
